2017 Block Kids Building Competition - Registration

The Block Kids Building Competition is a national building competition sponsored on the local level by the Montgomery Chapter NAWIC (National Association of Women in Construction). The award-winning program introduces children (Grades 3 - 6) to the construction industry in an effort to create an awareness of, and to promote an interest in, future careers in one of the many facets of the industry. The contest consists of the 45 minute construction of a "project" relevant to the construction industry made from plastic building blocks, a rock, a string, and a piece of aluminum foil. Each child's project is judged by construction professionals and other business people from our community utilizing predetermined criteria, and prizes are awarded for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd Place. 1st Place Winner's project will advance to the Regional Competitions. Every child that participates receives a goody bag, a plastic "hard hat", and a participation ribbon.
