SB XX

A Constitutional Amendment

- Creates Alabama Lottery
 Commission with members
 appointed by the Governor (2
 appointments), the Lt. Governor, the
 President ProTem of the Senate, and
 the Speaker of the House.
- The Commission will issue an RFP for a private corporation management team.
- Lottery management corporation will be a corporation and will not be state employees and may not contribute to political PACs or candidates.
- Allows Commission to issue one license per county for Video Lottery Terminals in Mobile, Greene, Lowndes, Macon and Jefferson counties.
- Sends all revenue to the Lottery Trust Fund.
- Allows the Commission to determine the games that are played, including interstate games.
- Subject to the Ethics Law, the Open Records Act, the Open Meetings Act, the Administrative Procedures Act.
- Video Lottery Terminal Tax set at 22%, plus another 1% if facility owns the terminals, plus a 1% local tax, plus 4% on Video Lottery Terminal vendors that lease machines.
- No casinos, cards, dice, dominos, roulette wheels or live dealers authorized.
- Charitable bingo unaffected by this c/a.

SB XX

A Legislative Act

- Proceeds from the Alabama Lottery and proceeds Video Lottery Terminals are deposited into the Lottery Trust Fund. The Lottery Trust Fund disburses all income equally to the Education Trust Fund and the General Fund. No funds are earmarked.
- Enumerates powers and duties of the Alabama Lottery Commission.
- Establishes that day to day management is by a private corporation selected by the Commission. There are no state employees.
- The Lottery Commission determines the type of games offered.
- The Commission establishes compensation to retailers.
- Time limit to cash in winning tickets.
- Must be 18 or older to purchase or cash in winning ticket.
- Money set aside for the Department of Public Health to help with compulsive gaming disorders and public education.
- Prize winners of \$250,000 and up may elect anonymity.
